If you were in band years ago, things have changed a lot! If you are new to this activity, there is much to learn. Please plan to attend this very important meeting. 6<sup>th</sup> Grade students can also rent or purchase their instrument and supplies at this meeting, as a music company will be on site.

# CARIO MIDDLE SCHOOL BAND SMARTMUSIC & MICROPHONE FORM

#### What is SmartMusic?

SmartMusic is award-winning interactive music software that provides the ideal practice environment. With a subscription to SmartMusic, students have unlimited access to the world's largest accompaniment library for all ages and skill levels, which includes thousands of pieces of music.

#### **How does SmartMusic work?**

Students open an assignment from their teachers, which contains customized instructions for playing a particular piece of music.

- As the music appears on the screen, they play along with background accompaniment.
- Following each performance, SmartMusic provides an immediate assessment, displaying the notes that students performed correctly in green and the notes they performed incorrectly in red.
- Students record and listen to each performance to hear how they really sound and how their part fits within the whole.
- When they are satisfied with their performance, they send a recording to their teacher who can assess, score, and build a portfolio to track their progress over time.

#### What do you need to do?

SmartMusic subscriptions are purchased by the Band Booster Club. They are paid for in advance and are not refundable.

- > All Students will receive an installation instruction sheet.
- > Students **MUST** activate the subscription on their home computer **NO LATER THAN** September 21<sup>st</sup>. If this is not completed, the subscription expires and you are responsible to purchase another copy.
- Subscriptions for existing accounts will expire September 1<sup>st</sup>, so 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade students must reactivate using the Installation Code.
- The software requires a microphone, which can be purchased through the band program. These microphones are specifically designed to use with instruments, and provide the best results with SmartMusic. If you own an ipad, the ipad does not need an external microphone. There is a built-in mic. Laptops with built in mics do not always work well. The microphone picks up sound better, as it clips right to the instrument.

# PRIVATE LESSONS ACADEMY AT CARIO MIDDLE SCHOOL

As a convenience to our parents, there will be a supervised weekly private lessons program located at Cario Middle School. The Lessons Academy will offer Charleston's finest teachers in one location to provide our students the opportunity to excel in music, while making getting to those lessons more convenient for our band parents! **No** need to drive across town in traffic! Lessons without the stress and lost time.

The private lessons staff consists of Charleston's finest teachers, symphony members and professional players. Each teacher has been approved by the band staff due to their track record of providing high quality lessons for the Cario community. In a recent study, over 80% of the students selected for All-State Band were enrolled in weekly private lesson instruction.

Lessons are on Wednesdays starting at 4 pm with the last lesson at 7:30 pm (lessons are 30 minutes). We will have two sessions, each lasting 15 weeks. Registration for Fall Lessons Academy begins August 22<sup>nd</sup>. There are limited spots available for each teacher, and the instructors will establish the rate for each lesson.


